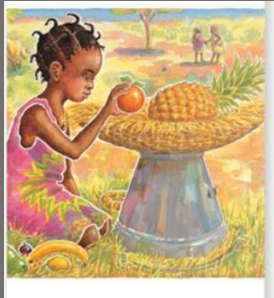


Autumn 2, Class1. Dance – Theme, Handa's Surprise

We will be creating our own sequence of moves to a range of different African rhythms. We will look at using different pathways for our movements.



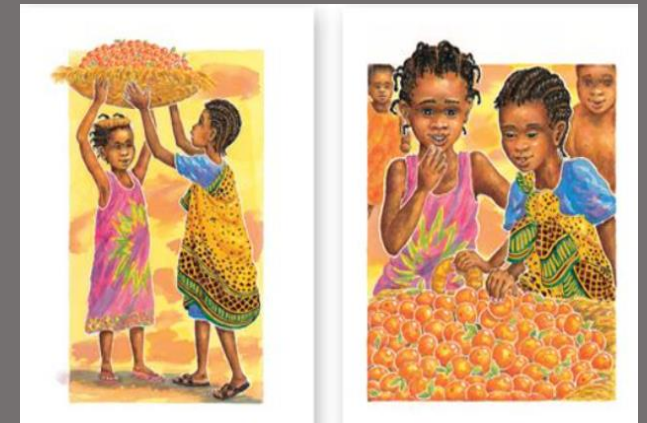
To create our dances, we will be looking at the key Elements:
