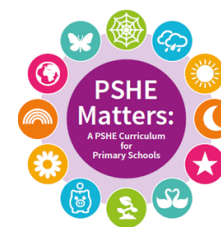

### Things to discuss at home:

- Where does money come from?
- How do people get money?
- What do people spend money on?
- Why do people save money?
- When and why might they donate/share money?
- What is the difference between things we want and things we need?
- How do we keep our money safe?
- How do you think it feels to be paid money for work/jobs done?

### Activities you could do at home:

Create a list of things you want and things you need. Discuss, as a family, where money could be saved.

Put some coins in a jar at home and create a price list for things at home (ie time on games consoles, treats) and ask the children to find the right payment. Children could also earn more coins by completing chores around the house.
