Two of the world's highest volcanoes are found in South America - Mt. Chimborazo and Mt. Cotopaxi.

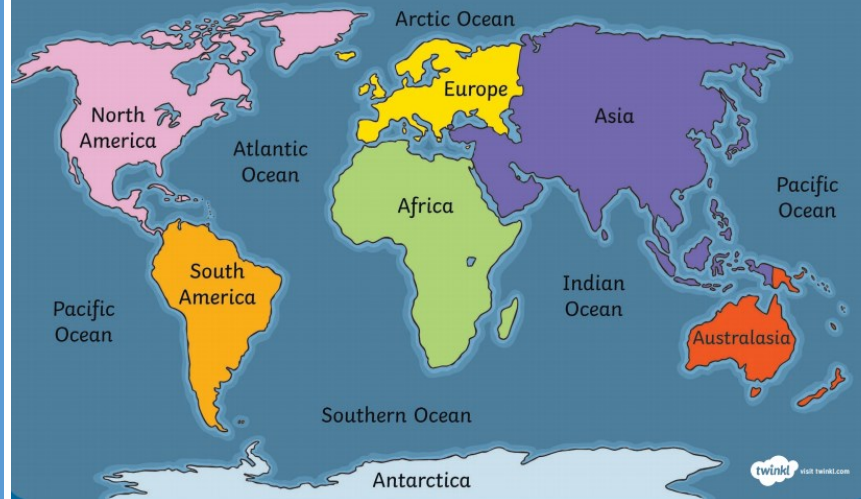
Mastering Components - Australasia
