

Year Four — Number and Place Value



Key Vocabulary

Zero	The number before one. It has no value. It is neither positive or negative.
Ones	A single unit
Tens	10 ones is equal to 1 ten.
Hundreds	100 ones or 10 tens is equal to one hundred
Thousands	1000 ones or 100 tens or 10 hundreds is equal to one thousand
Place Value	The value represented by the digits based on their position in a number
Numeral	A symbol or a name that represents a number
Digit	A single symbol used to make a numeral—ie 1-digit number, 2-digit number
Partition	To break a number down into different parts
Order	To sequence numbers based on their value either from smallest to greatest (ascending) or greatest to smallest (descending)
Compare	Look for similarities and/or differences between at least two objects or numbers.
Greater than	Compare two different values and identifies the larger amount
Less than	Compare two different values and identifies the smaller amount
Round	To use the nearest multiple (usually nearest 10 or 100) in order to make estimating and calculating easier
Negative number	A number that is less than zero.
Roman Numeral	A system of symbols used to represent numbers that were developed by the Romans

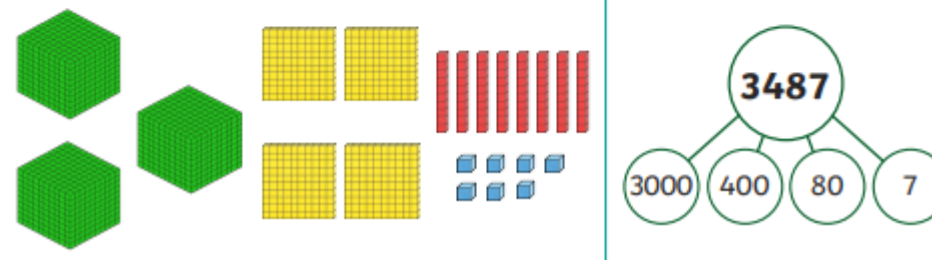
