
Measure	To find the size of something in a given unit
Length	A linear measurement - The length of this pencil is shorter than yours
Distance	A measure between two points or things
Long	An adjective used to describe length - My hair is long.
Short	An adjective used to describe length—This pencil is short
Standard unit	A uniform measure i.e. centimetres on a ruler




#### A ruler

Each mark is 1cm. Always remember to start at 0cm






The blue pencil is <u>9cm</u> long.




#### <u>Stem sentences - Height</u>



## Year 1 - Measurement - Weight & Capacity



Measure	To find the size of something in a given unit
Scales	An object used to measure mass (the weight of something)
Weight	The force exerted on an object by gravity. The weight of this book is heavier than the pencil.
/olume	A quantity or amount of any substance and the 3Dspace it fills i.e. The bottle holds the volume of one litre but its capacity is two litres. The bottle is half full.
Full	Contains or holds as much as possible. The juice carton is not full because I drank some
Empty	Containing nothing. There is no more water left. The jug is empty.
Capacity	The amount of liquid a container can hold
Balance	A measuring tool used to weigh objects. The two objects balance which means they are the same mass.
