



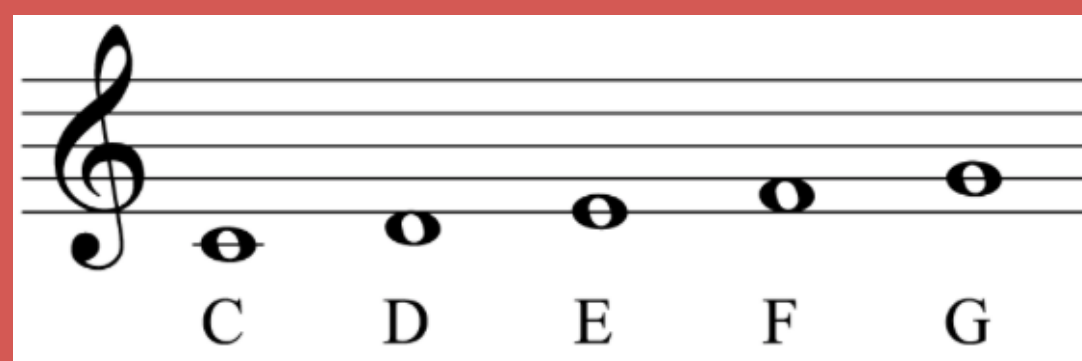

Fanfare	A short ceremonial tune or flourish played on brass instruments
Form	The structure of a musical composition
Dynamics	The variation in loudness between notes and phrases
Timbre	The character or quality of musical sound
