Holy Trinity	The three persons of God: The Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
Sacrifice	A sacrifice is an act of giving up something to God.
Pentecost	A Christian Holy Day celebrated 50 days after Easter; when we remember the coming of the Holy Spirit to Jesus' disciples.
Holy Spirit	The Holy Spirit inspires, guides, and empowers believers to live a life of faith and love.
Acts of the Apostles	A book written by Luke which shares how the apostles spread the Good News about Jesus Christ.
Intercession	The act of prayer or petition on behalf of another.
