













Christ be in my heart


But they were terribly afraid and began to say to one another, "Who is this man? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"




In our Gospel story today, we heard that the disciples were scared and then they turned to Jesus to give them peace and safety. We can always turn to Jesus when we are scared.






