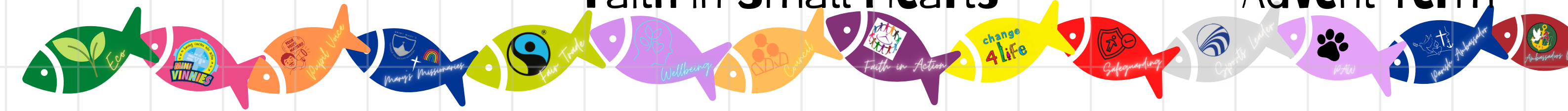

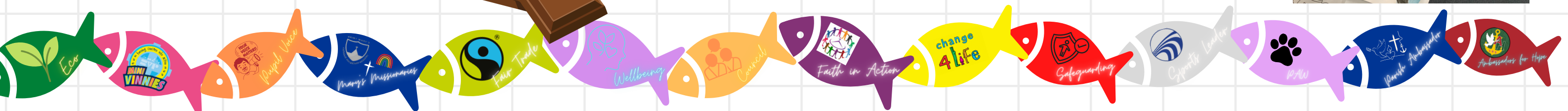

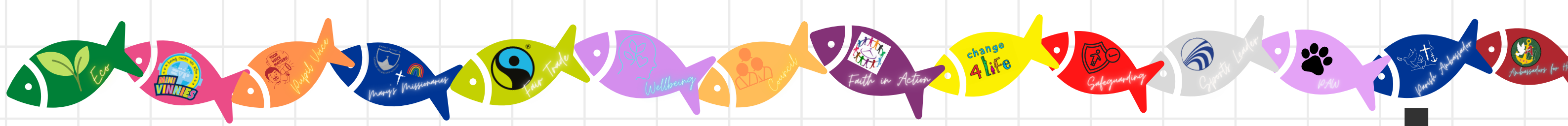
Fairtrade Team



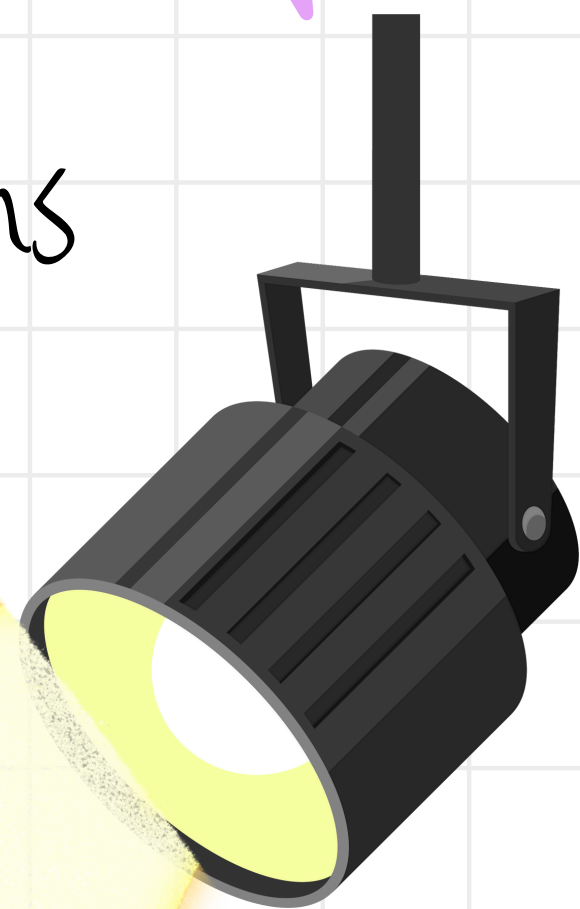
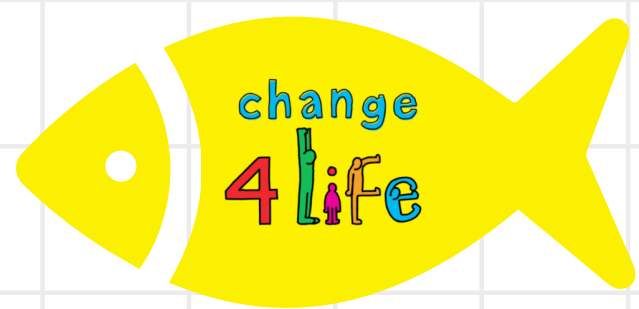
